

Variety		Height	Characteristics
Ilex aquifolium	Argenteo-marginatus	15-20'	Shiny dark green leaves with creamy white margins. Bright red berries in winter. Requires a male pollinator for berries to set. Use Gold Coast to pollinate.
Ilex aquifolium	Gold Coast	4-6'	Very dense, compact growth habit. Dark green leaves are edged in bright yellow. Male form with no berries, but will pollinate other hollies.
Ilex aquifolium	Hedgehog	15-20'	
Ilex aquifolium	Myrtifolia	6-8'	Great for containers or smaller gardens. Very slow growing.
Ilex aquifolium	Nellie R. Stevens	12-18'	This extremely vigorous growing holly is great for hedging. Female species-requires male to produce berries.
Ilex cornuta	Dazzler	8-10'	An evergreen shrub with abundant red berries for winter! Spines on the margins of the foliage. Great for Christmas greenery.
Ilex cornuta	Needlepoint	8-10'	Valued for its delicate, narrow, twisted leaves and heavy crop of bright red fruit that lasts through winter. Performs well as a lush screen, border, accent or foundation plant.
Ilex meserveae	Blue Girl	6-7'	The hardies of all hollies. Bright red berries stand out against blue-green foliage. Makes a great hedge.
Ilex meserveae	Blue Prince	12-15'	Great as a background plant or hedge. Good pollinator for female hollies.



Variety		Height	Characteristics
Ilex meserveae	Castle Spire	8-10'	Compact, pyramidal form. Dark green leaves with bright red berries. Use Castle Wall to pollinate.
Ilex meserveae	Castle Wall	5-8'	Great compact, pyramidal form. Great in place of Yew hedging. Use to pollinate Castle Spire.
Ilex meserveae	Dragon Lady	10-15'	Dark green foliage and dark purple stems. Large red berries in winter.
Osmanthus heterophylla	Goshiki	3-4'	New growth has a pinkish-orange variegation. As the shrub matures the variegation in leaves turns creamy yellow.
Osmanthus heterophylla	Purpurea	10-15'	Foliage is dark purple in young plants. Mature foliage is a purple-toned deep green.
Osmanthus heterophylla	Variegata	8-10'	Slow growing with densely set leaves edged in creamy white. Great for shady areas.
Osmanthus heterophyllus	Aureo-marginatus	4-5'	Beautifully variegated green and yellow foliage. Very slow growing.
